The first agenda item was a vote from the committee members on the pending landscaping requests:

- Gay's request to clean out rock-lined ditch in front of 11612 at her own expense. We all agreed that the ditch was suffering from an erosion/runoff issue and that the ditch would look and operate better if it were clean. I all voted in agreement that Gay should be allowed to do this.

Judith wanted to have further discussion on the above item; the rest of the Committee wanted to move forward to the next item since a vote had been taken and the item was approved. Keith indicated he would like to move on, and then Judith addressed Keith abruptly. Eric intervened and commented that Judith, Beulah & D'Orsay were being disruptive; Beulah said she would take care of that and, at that point, Beulah, D'Orsay, and Judith stood up, resigned, and walked out of the pavilion. After a brief pause, the remainder of the Committee continued with the items on the agenda as follows:

1. We voted and recommended approval Jackie's request to plant **annuals** in her back patio.
2. We voted and recommended approval to replace the **purple azalea** that is in front of Beverly Bugos' unit. A suitable location for the azalea and a volunteer to transplant it still needs to be identified. Suzanne offered to move the azalea for Beverly; Jackie suggested we plant these near the pavilion.
3. We voted and recommended approval for planting two **forsythia** cuttings donated to the community by Teri (@ 2102 Green Watch). Jackie suggested we plant these near the pavilion.
4. It was agreed it would be better to wait until Fall to move the **daffodils** from in front of Beverly's yard, as well as splitting and moving any more hostas.
5. Keith said he would like to propose that the grassy common areas behind 2112-2122 Green Watch Way be used as a **test area for grass reseeding**. He will write a proposal, with a list of materials, to address the work to be done, type of grass seed to use, soil amendments, etc. for review by the committee.

6. We agreed to continue refining and adding to the list of **acceptable plants** for the Woodwinds Community.
7. We agreed to work on a list of **acceptable hardscape materials** to be used in Woodwinds.
8. We discussed notifying the community of what **poison ivy** looks like, and it was agreed that the townhouse residents are the people most likely to come in contact with the poison ivy and we will target them for notification.
9. We discussed the fact that the Landscaping Committee's **2007 budget** will be impacted by addressing the enormous areas of erosion and that will leave little money for anything else.
10. We discussed requesting a proposal from Blade Runners for **watering** of annuals.

The meeting was adjourned shortly before 8:00 p.m.
